GROSS MAN HOURS (INCLUDING OVERHEAD) EXPENDED - In Millions

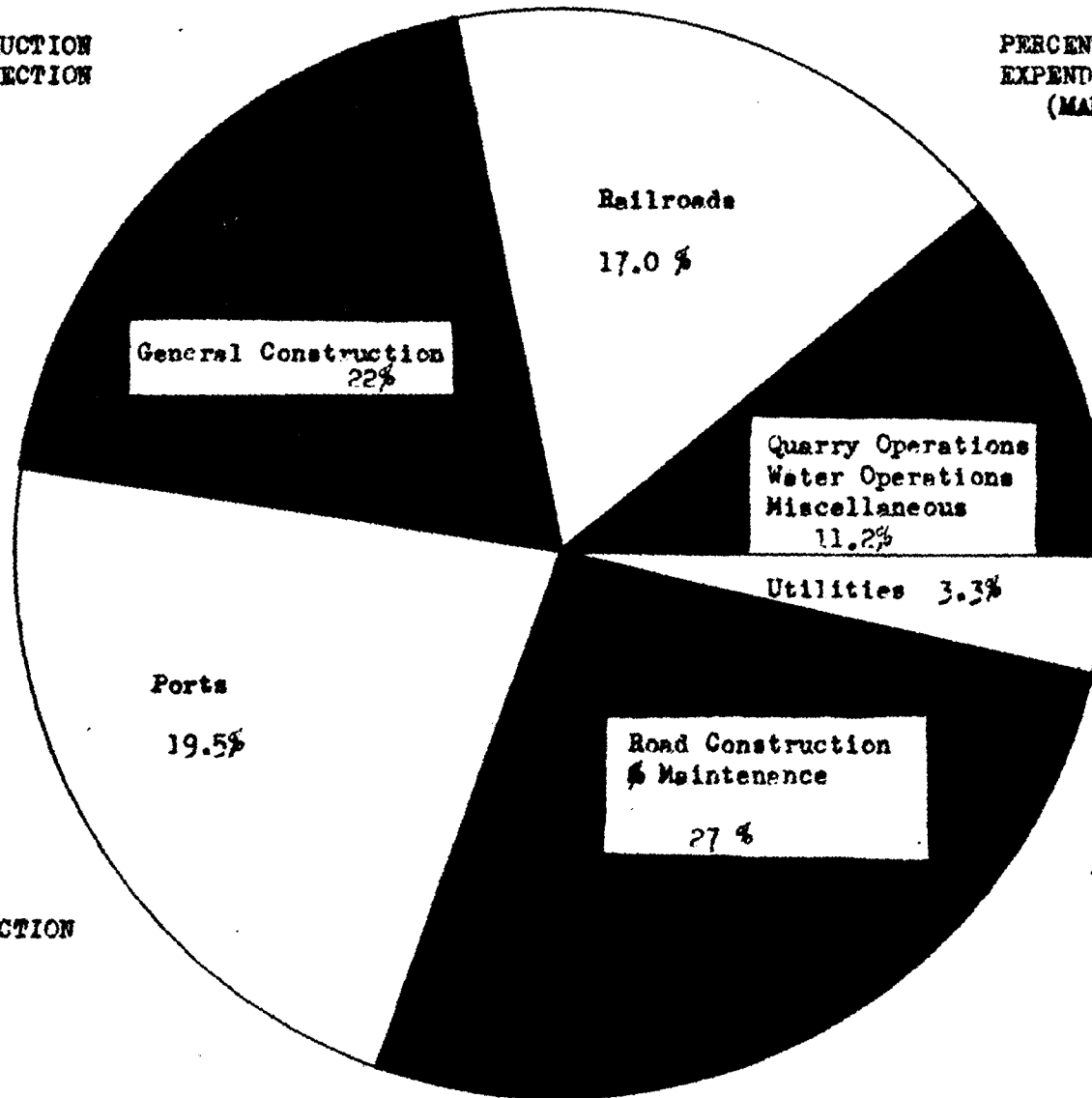

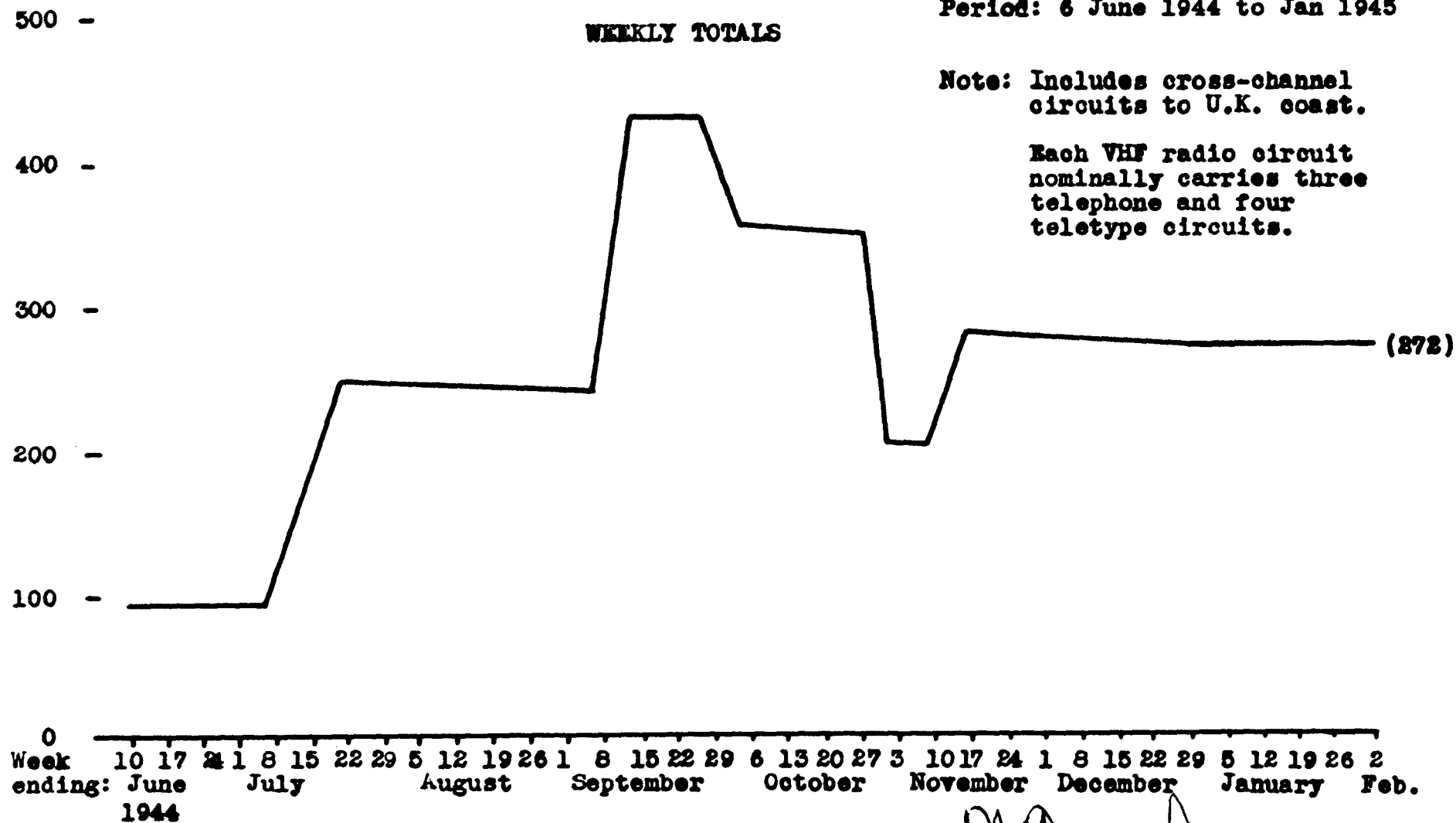

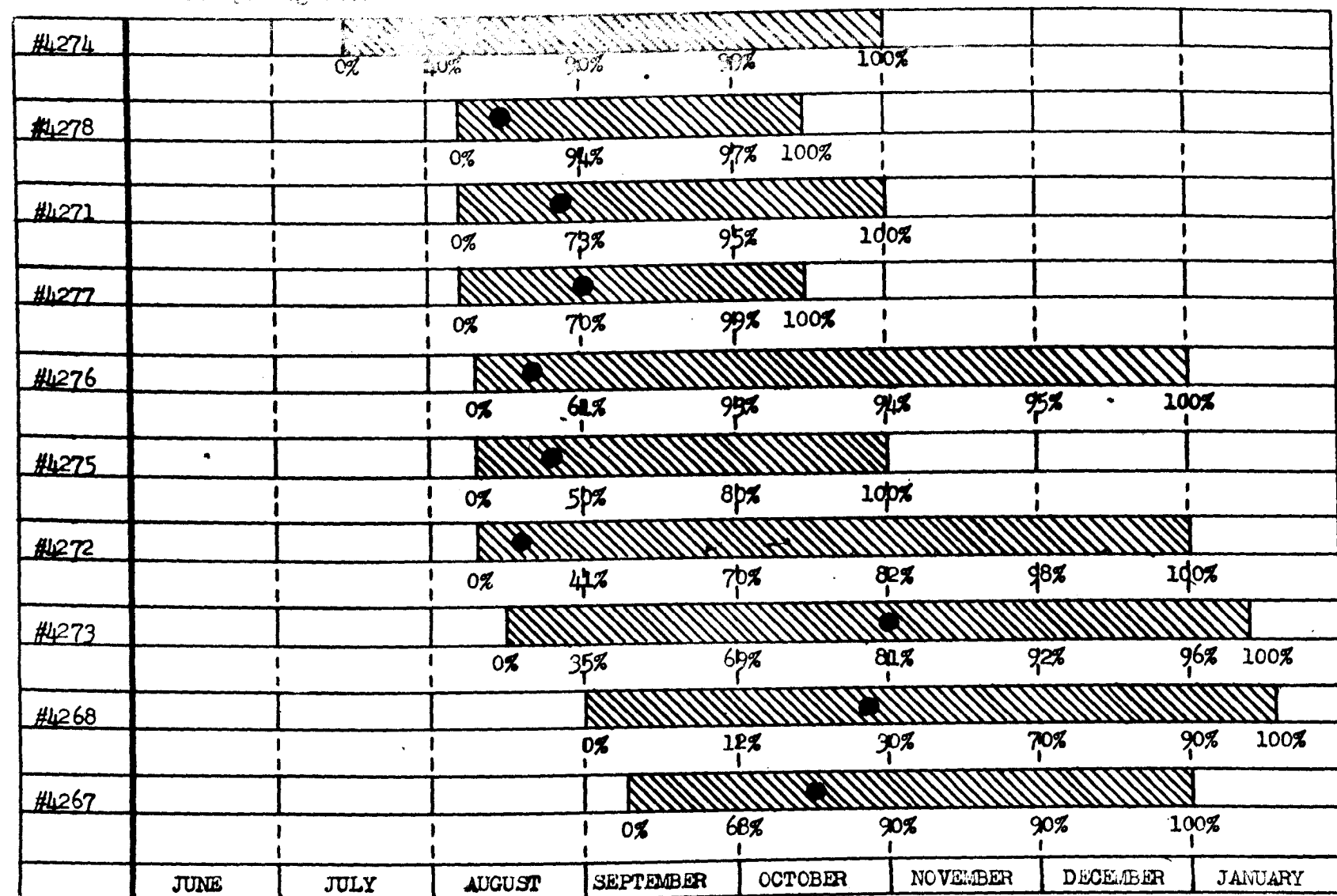
CONSTRUCTION STATUS PROGRESS CHART

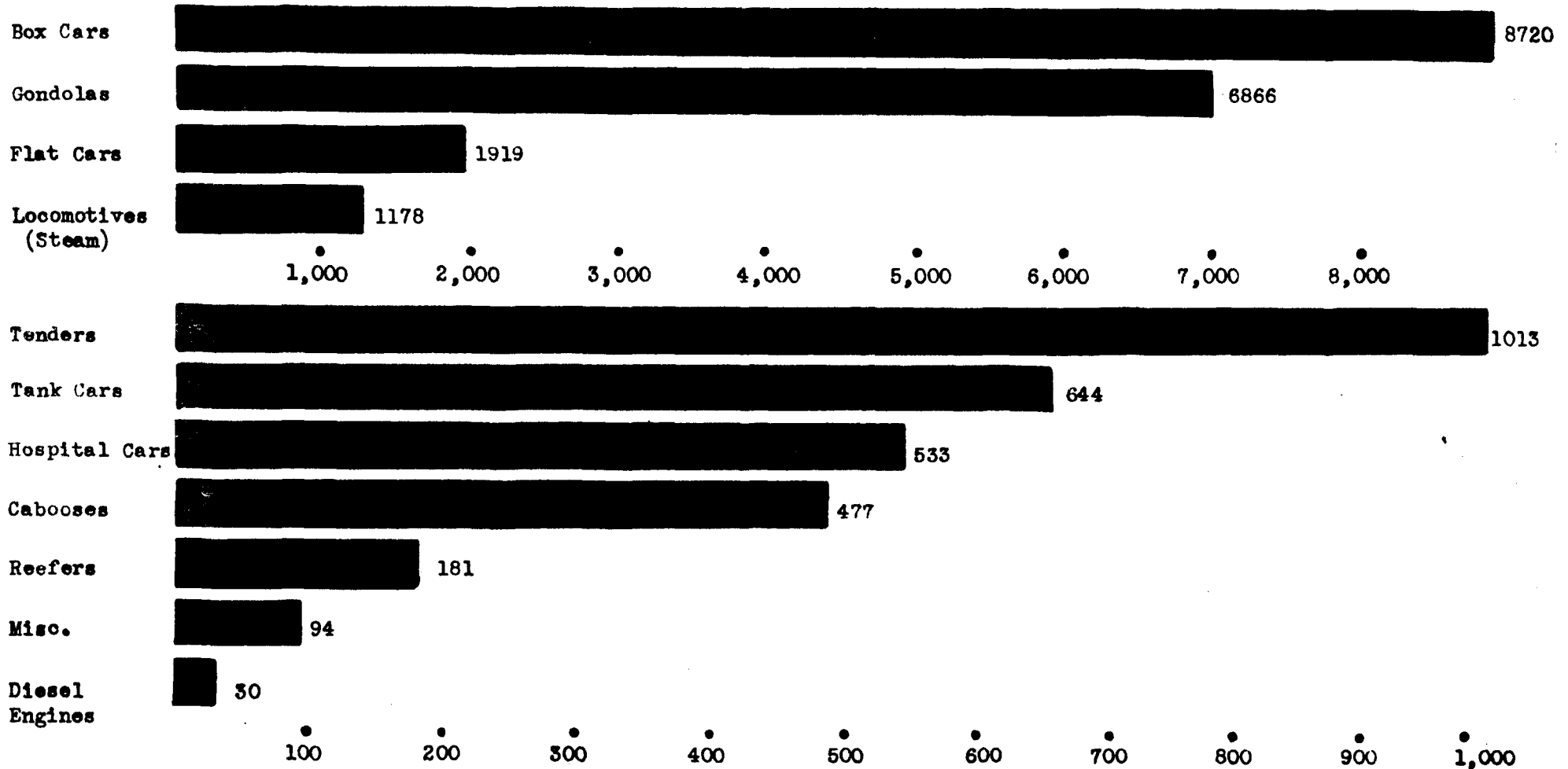


ROLLING STOCK DISCHARGED AT CHERBOURG

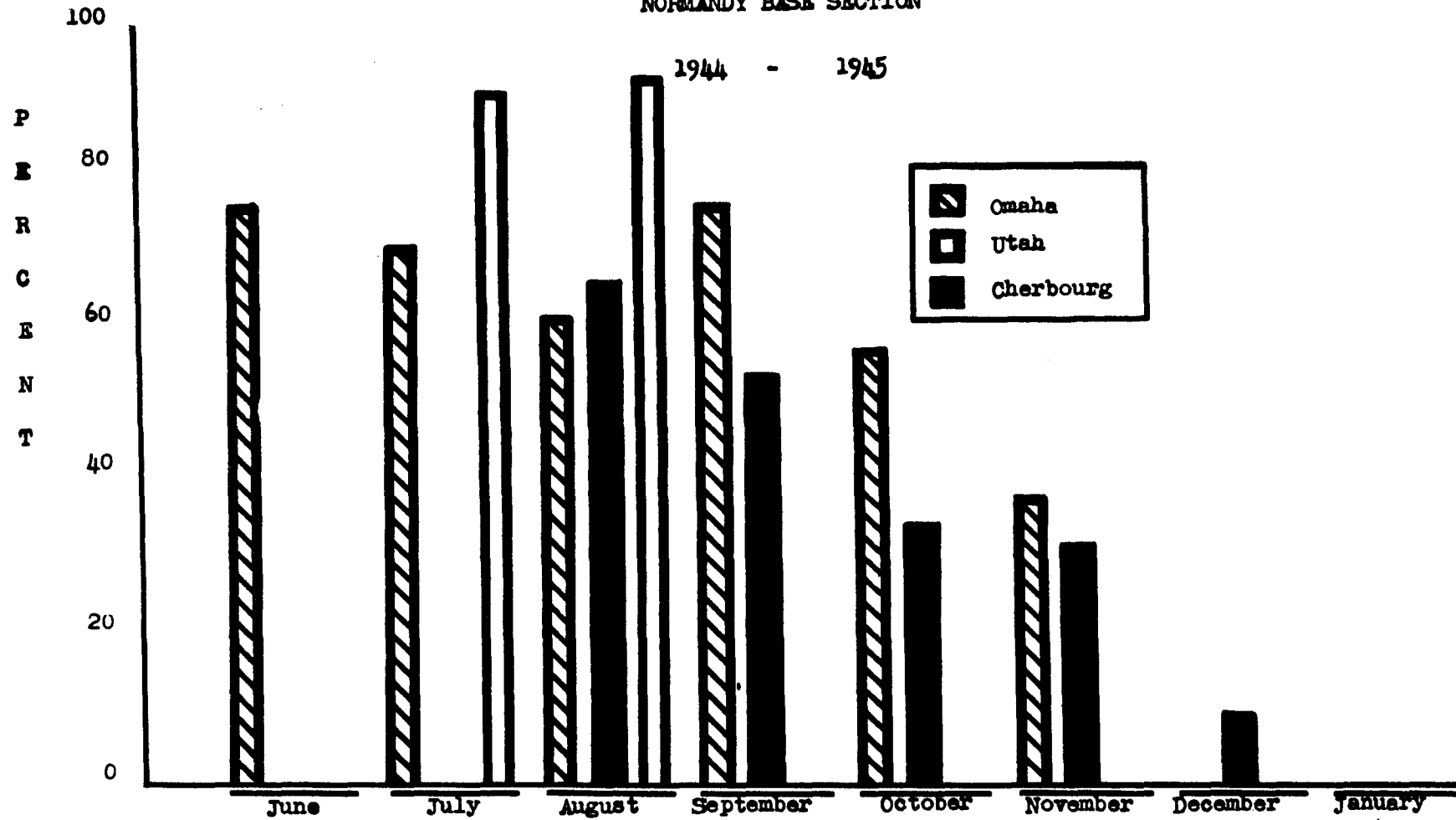

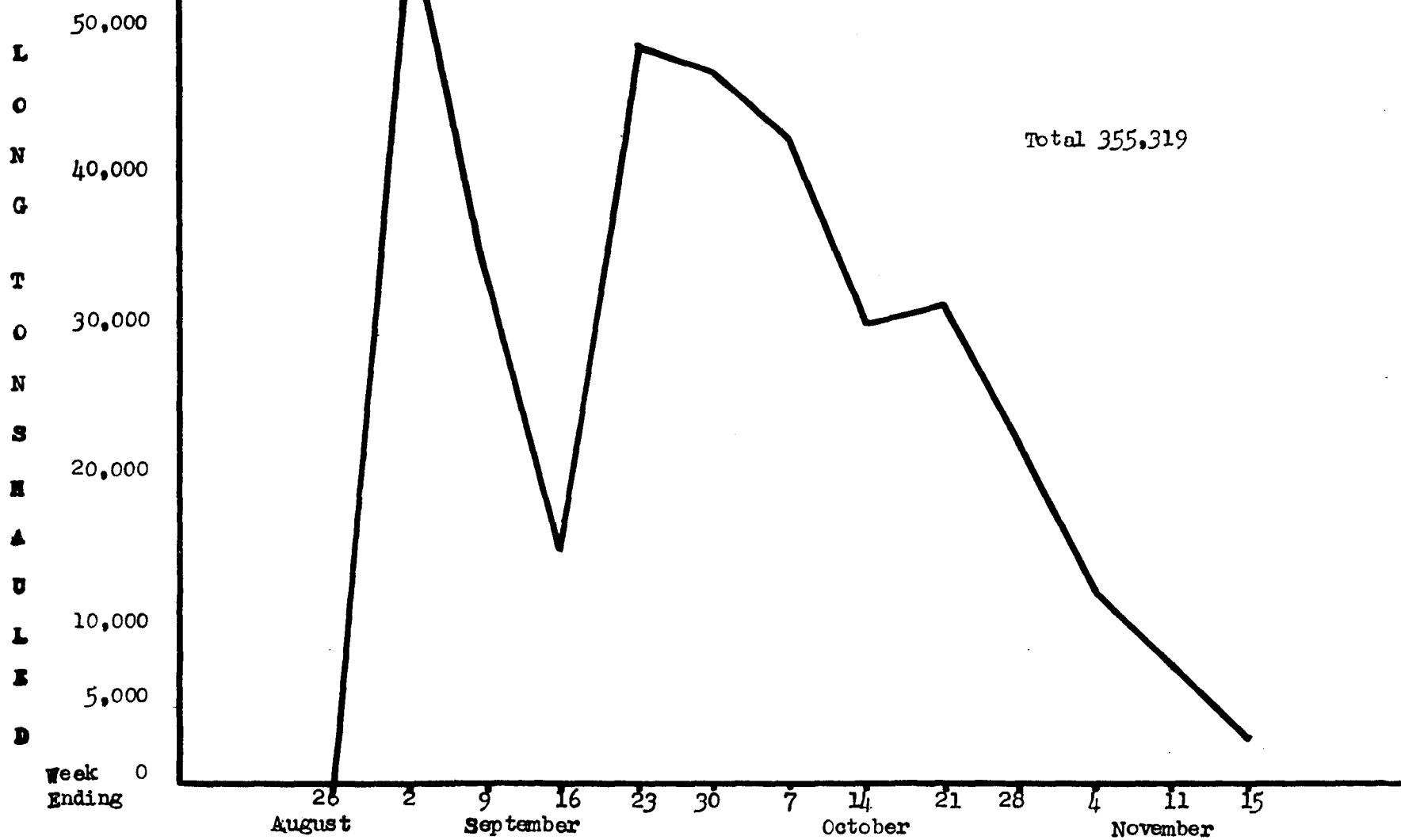

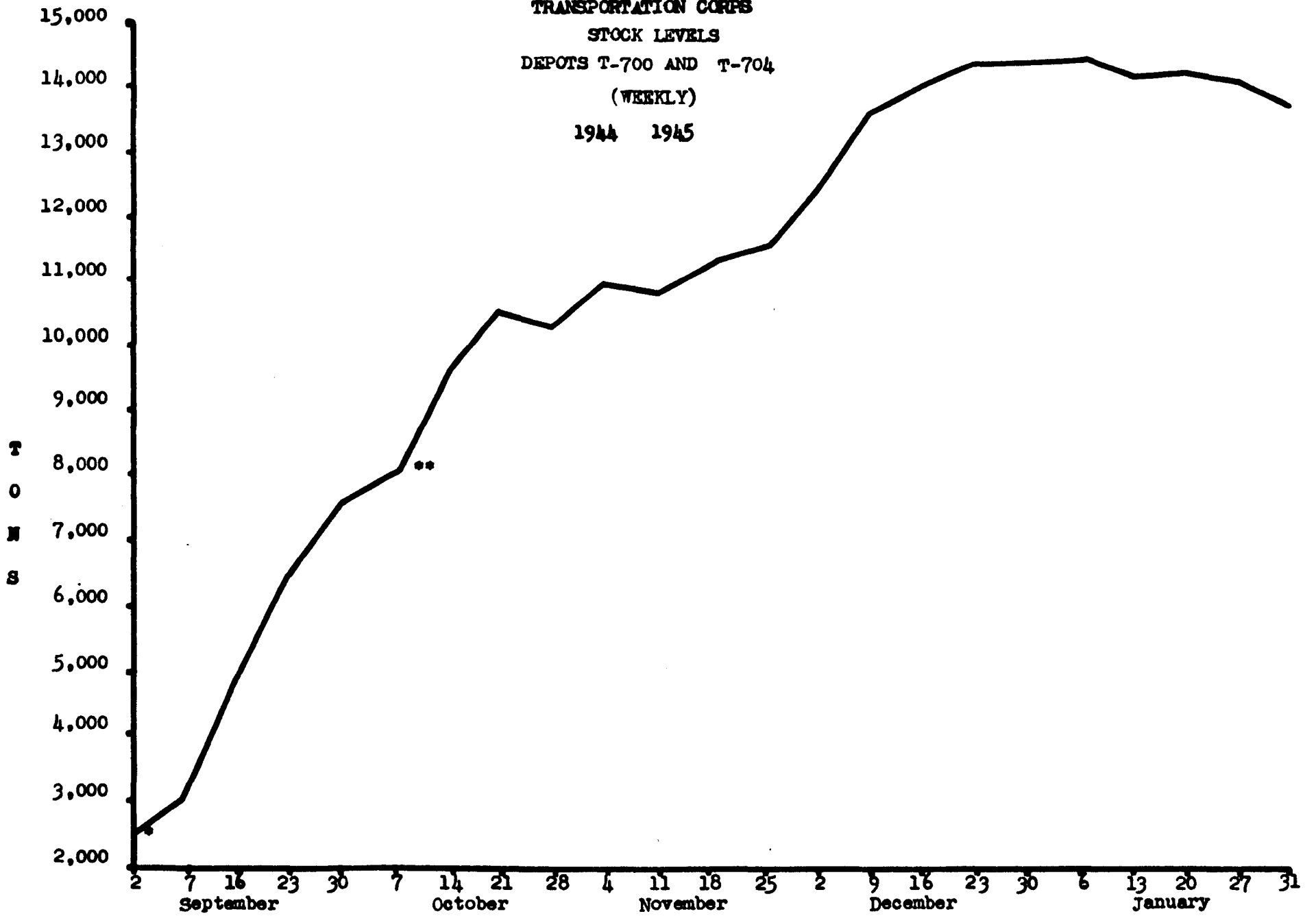

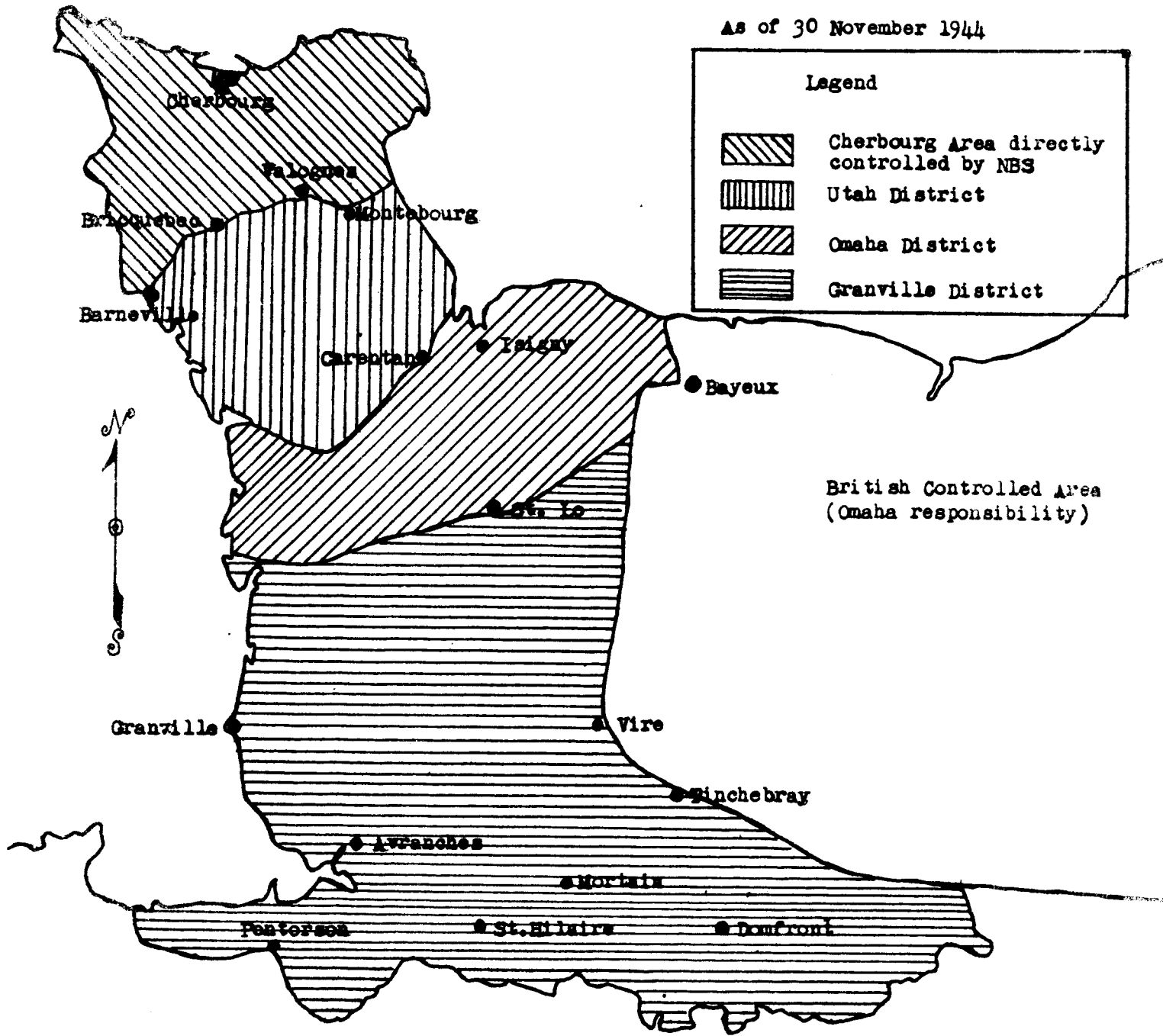



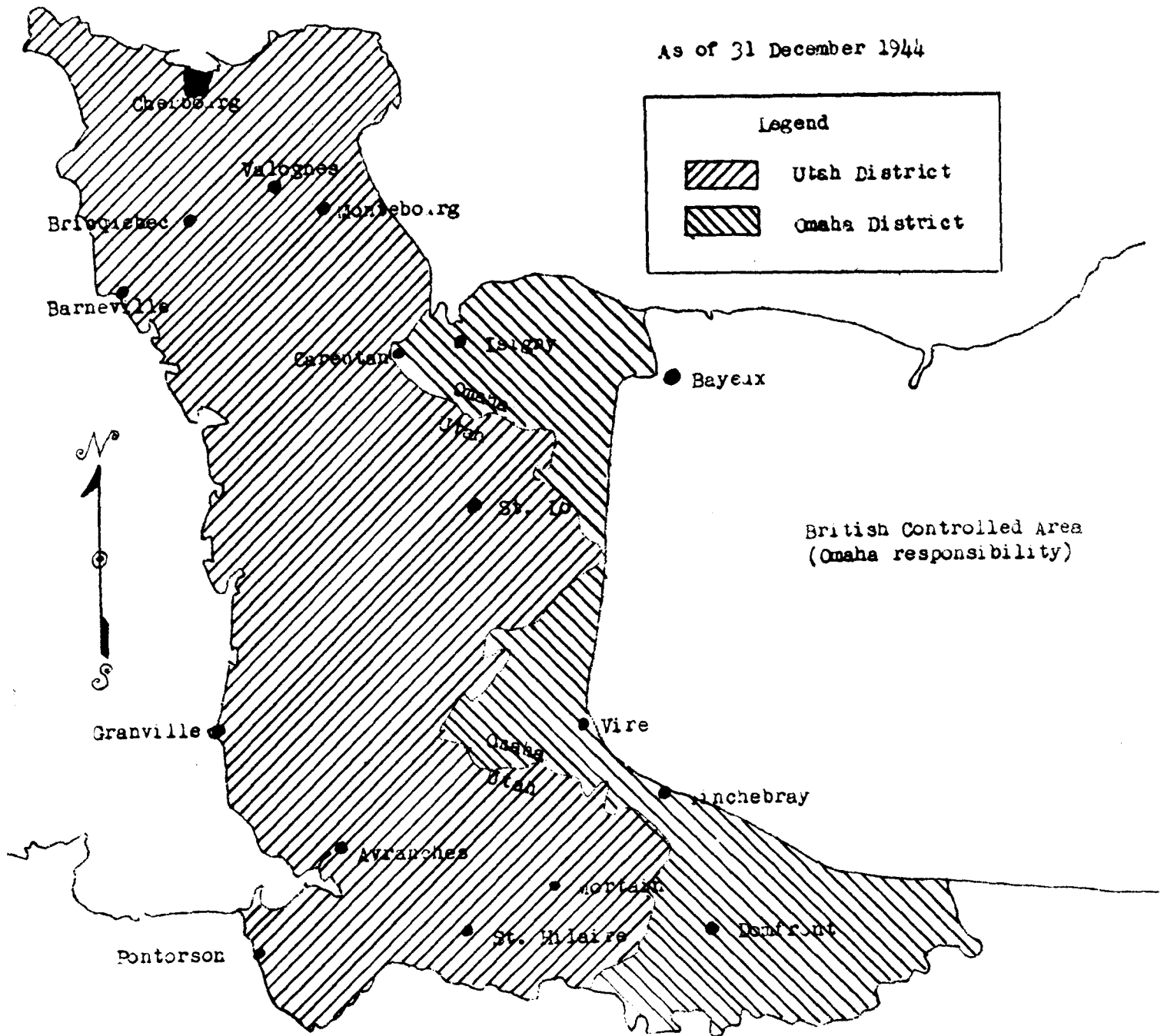

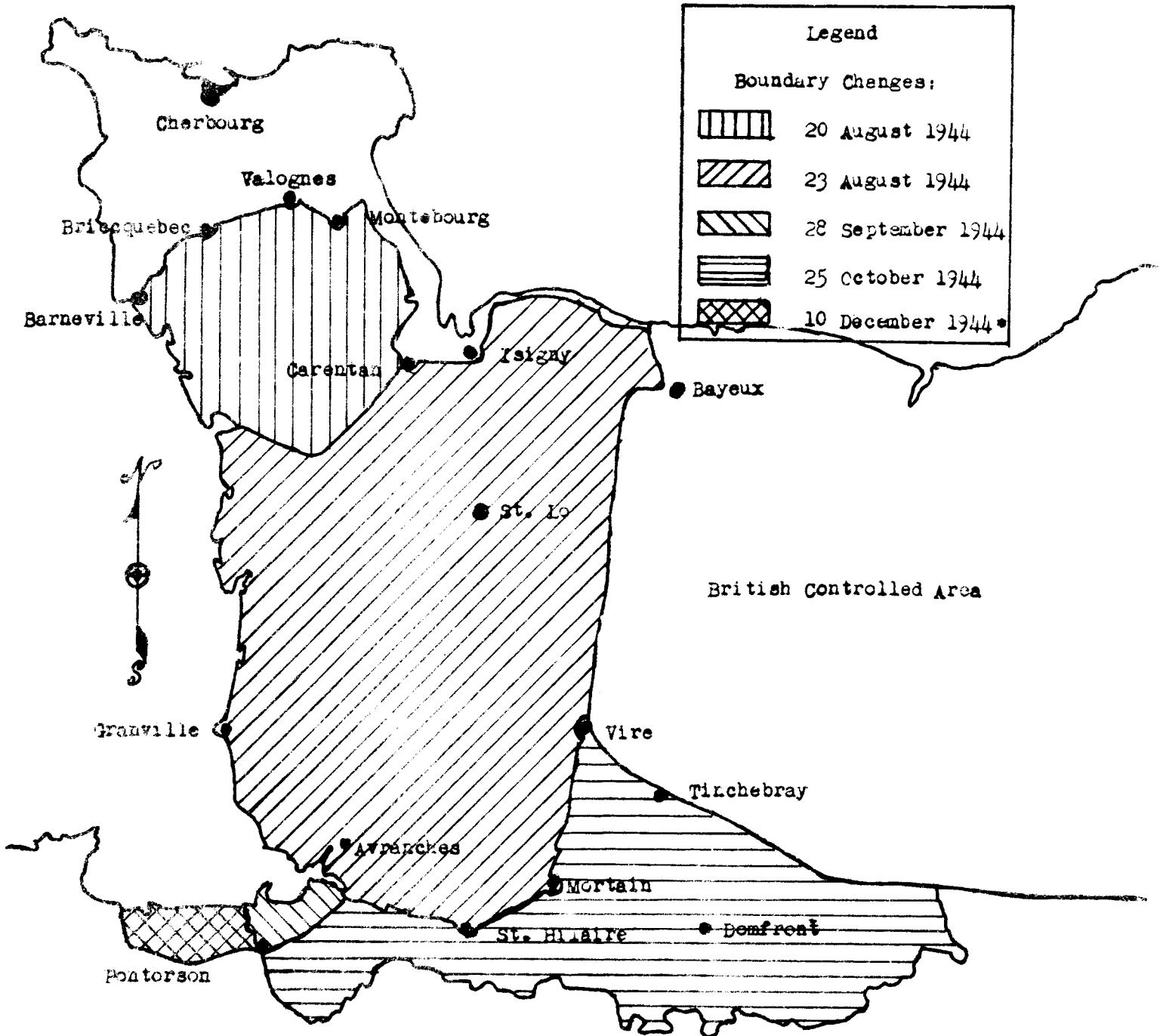

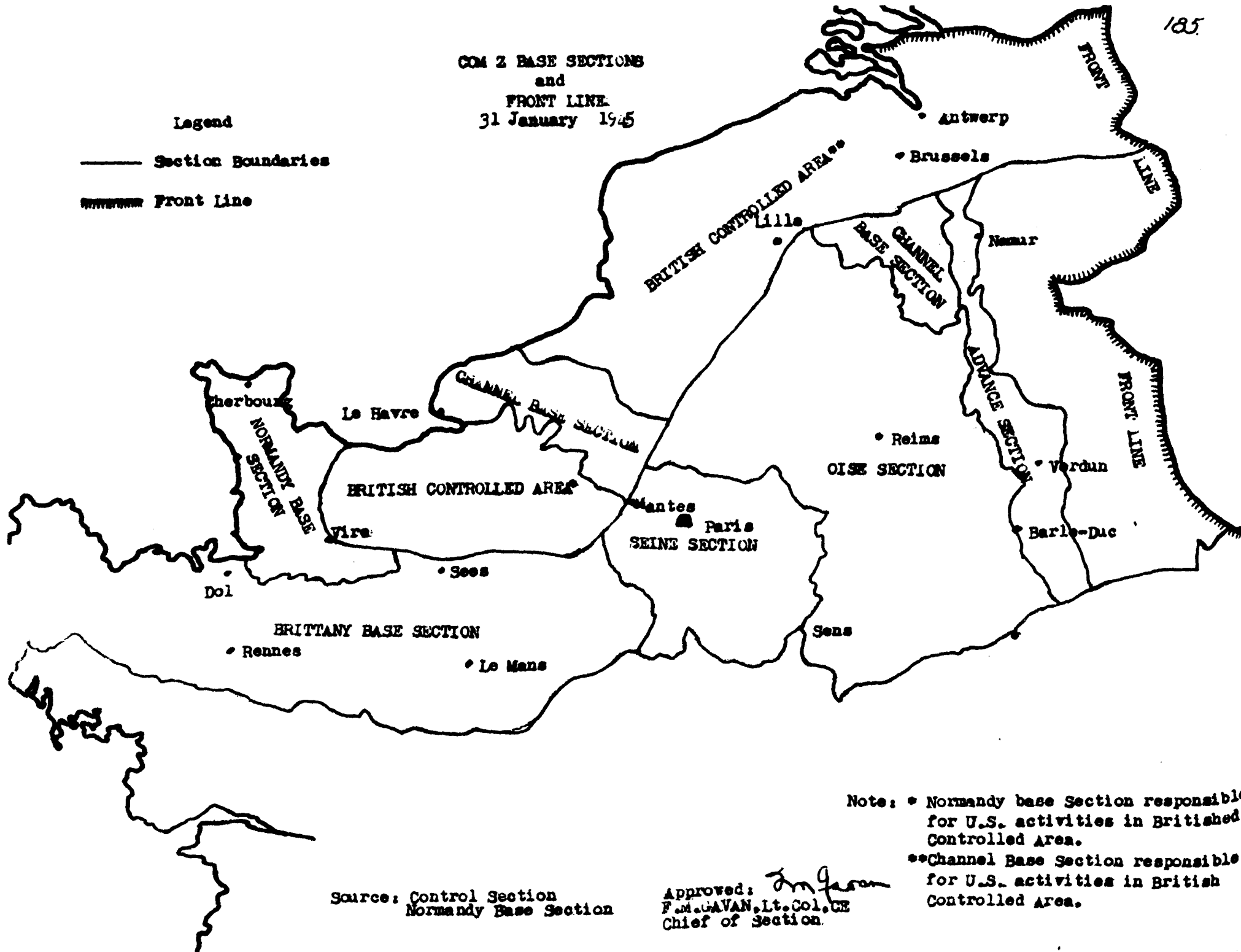

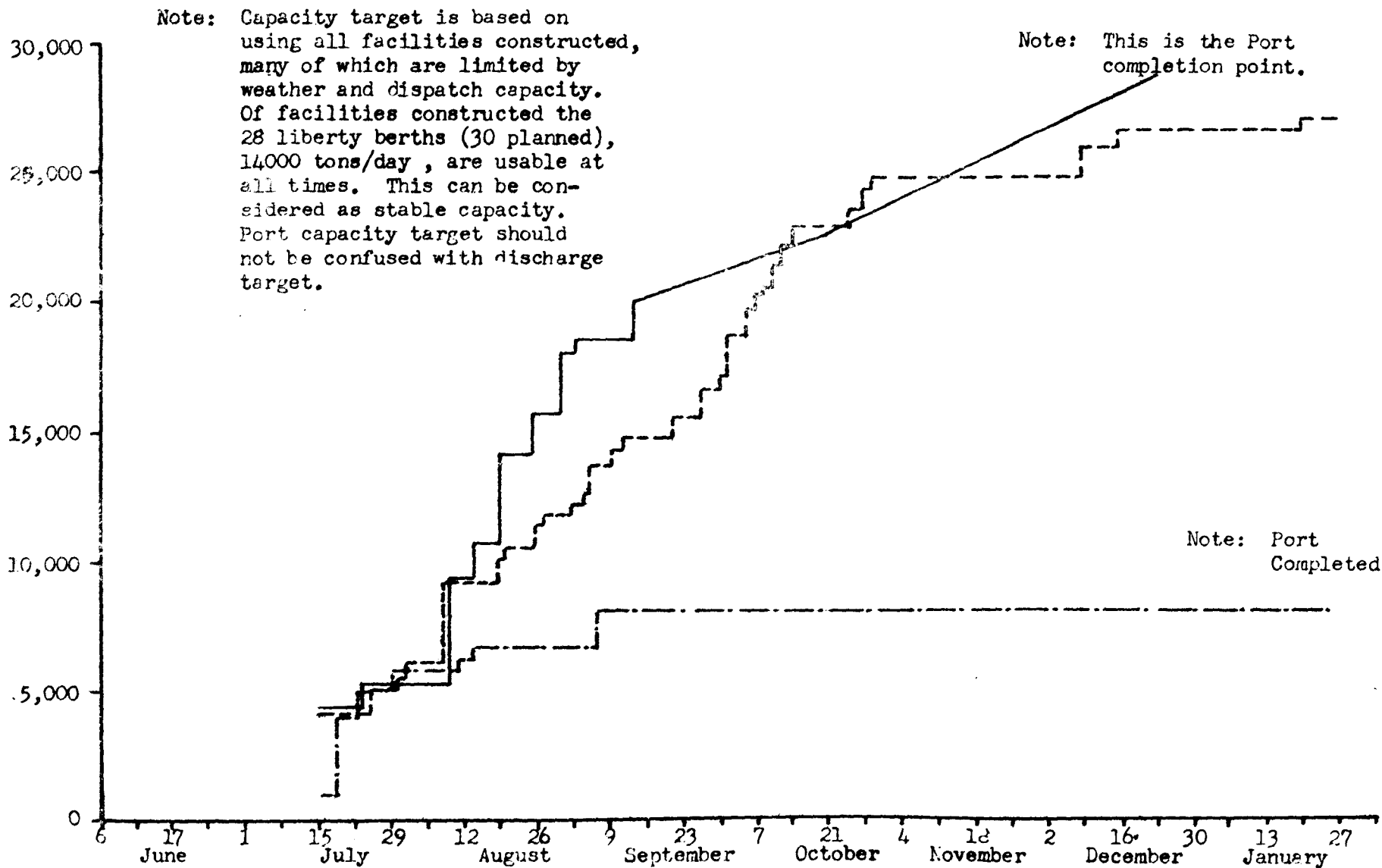

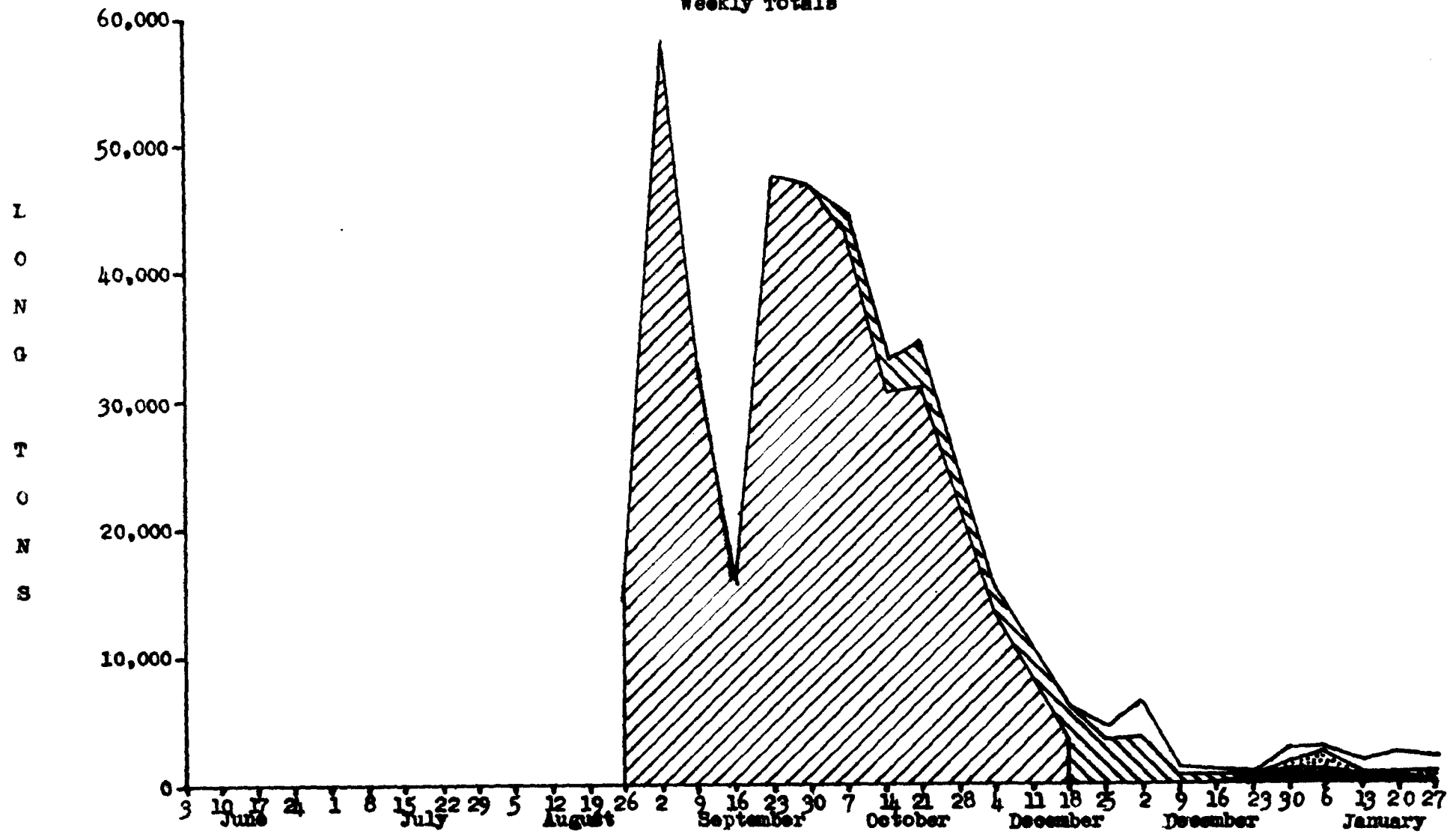
